Scholarship Offers Individuals Opportunity for Free College Summer Session

Kilgore, TX, June 8, 2010: The Workforce Solutions East Texas Board announces the “Earn, Learn, WIN Scholarship” for Summer 2010 for individuals up to age 24. Scholarships will be awarded for up to \$3,000 and includes tuition and books paid for the summer sessions, employment for up to 10 weeks at 24 hours/week and a scholarship for fall at the college/university of their choice.

Eligible applicants must be either a recent graduate or attained a GED and never attended college. Applicants may also be a past graduate/GED recipient and have previously attended college with limited success.

Interested individuals should complete the application available [online](#) or at your local workforce center, and include the following:

- A current grade report from your high school or an official college transcript (if previously attended)
- A typed letter that includes:
 - The reasons the applicant believes they may benefit from the scholarship
 - Explanation of the college course(s) (English, Math, History, Psychology, Developmental) they are interested in attending and why
- A letter of recommendation from a present or past teacher, coach, counselor, administrator or employer.

Applications must be only for the summer session and are to be turned in at a local Workforce Solutions East Texas Center. The application period will be open as long as funds are available. For more information, contact Wendell Holcombe, Director of Workforce, at 903.984.8641 x254.
